The government has announced that from the 4th of July pubs, restaurants and hairdressers may reopen as long as they adhere to COVID-19 secure guidelines. To begin restoring the arts and culture sector, some leisure facilities and tourist attractions may also reopen, if they can do so safely.

Based on the official announcement; we have decided to start the life drawing sessions from September. A [booking](#) is required due to COVID-19 social distancing requirements.

The following health and safety guidelines are in place, and we expect all artists to adhere to them.

1. Pre booking is required and no dropping.
2. The main door is opened from 7.00 pm, and you can enter with recommended social distancing.
3. Social distancing information will be displayed at the venue as relevant.
4. Hand sanitisers are provided and required to use on arrival and whenever needed. Bring your own hand sanitisers if you have concerns of using communal hand sanitisers.
5. Seating arrangements are made to maintain 2m social distancing between the participants.
6. Face covering is required as per the [Government Guidance](#).
7. Face masks and gloves are provided to use if required.
8. The kitchen area is closed, and please bring your food and drink if needed.
9. The accessible toilet is available for common use, and hand sanitisers and cleaning materials are provided.
10. Chairs are cleaned before the arrival of artists using recommended cleaning materials.
11. Once the session is over, the organisers will clean the premise thoroughly.
12. Please bring your art materials such as pencils, rubber, etc.
13. Consumable items such as drawing papers, pencils, rubber are available. However, once you collect them; they should NOT be returned.
14. Cleaned drawing boards and clips are available. They need to be returned to the dedicated location marked.
15. Only contactless card payments will be accepted, and you will get a receipt via text message onto your mobile phone.
16. The organisers will open the main door at the end of the session allowing the artists to leave with recommended social distancing.

17. All fire exits (i.e. three) will be kept open during the sessions to have proper ventilation through fresh air.
18. The doorknobs and padlocks will be cleaned by the organisers as needed.
19. All artists and the model are required to adhere to the guidelines for the safety of everyone.
20. Mornington Hall may have its COVID-19 safety guidelines, and you are required to respect them too.
21. If you are not feeling well or have symptoms of fever; please do not attend.
22. Also, if you experience any COVID-19 symptoms within 14 days of attending any sessions; please inform the organisers in the earliest possible.

Notes to the Models

1. There is a designated area to keep the personal belongings and to change.
2. Floor mats, throws, cushion covers, etc. are cleaned before the arrival of the model. However, you may bring clothes/sheets to cover them if needed.
3. Hand sanitisers are available. You can bring your own if needed.
